Bus 60 has a bus stop in either direction near the end of the bridle path. This heads towards Sandbanks or Poole. The house is on a bridle way. It has a red post box at the end of it and this is a good marker to know where it is.

A 'hideaway' cottage on a bridle path in Lilliput.

A lovely cottage set on a bridle path in a quiet setting just a 5 minutes' walk to the local amenities of Lilliput and Salterns Marina. From here you can run down to the water's edge and along to Sandbanks and then a run on the beach. Or just walk and enjoy the views!

Lilliput is a lovely small village feel with a small walk to Evening Hill and then onto sandbanks. Lilliput offers a co-op, Tesco Express, cafe, bakers and a fish and chip shop. There is also a well-liked Thai restaurant. Sandbanks is a 15 minutes' walk. There is a bus stop at the end of the bridle path which can take you to Rockley Park or Poole and in the other direction Sandbanks. The walk to Evening Hill is lovely and then onto the beaches of Sandbanks. Salterns Marina with the Salterns Harbourside Hotel with its restaurant and bar is a lovely setting.

Day trips and places to go
